To be eligible to apply for one of these bursaries applicants must:

- be a current full or part time post graduate student in the field of ageing or one year post completion of a PhD in this area (Masters, Doctoral or one year Post-Doctoral programs)
- have an abstract accepted for an oral or poster presentation at the congress
- be registered to attend the congress
- not be in receipt of funding to attend the congress from their university, workplace or other award program.
